- TO:** Providers of Pharmaceutical Services
- SUBJECT:** Eligibility Limits for Calendar Year 2007 for Pharmaceutical Assistance to the Aged and Disabled (PAAD), Lifeline, HAAAD, and Senior Gold
- EFFECTIVE:** **January 1, 2007**
- PURPOSE:** To notify providers, beneficiaries and the general public of the new income eligibility limits for calendar year 2007 for PAAD, Lifeline, HAAAD, and Senior Gold.
- BACKGROUND:** In accordance with NJSA 30:4D-21b, eligibility limits are adjusted each year to reflect the amount of the Social Security cost of living adjustment (COLA).
- The COLA for calendar year 2007 is 3.3%. Based on the COLA, the PAAD, Lifeline and HAAAD annual income limits adjust to \$22,572 for single persons and to \$27,676 for married persons. The Senior Gold annual income limits for single persons are between \$22,572 and \$32,572 and married persons must have annual combined income of between \$27,676 and \$37,676. These income eligibility limits are effective January 1, 2007.
