SUBJECT: To notify pharmacy providers of the changes to the
Pharmaceutical Assistance to the Aged and Disabled (PAAD)
and Senior Gold (SG) Prescription Discount Program.

EFFECTIVE: Claims with service dates on or after July 1, 2010.

BACKGROUND: Effective July 1, 2010, the State FY11 Appropriations Act
requires the following changes to the PAAD and Senior Gold Programs.

ACTION:

PAAD Co-pay change

For PAAD claims with service dates on or after July 1, 2010, the co-pay for generic
drugs will decrease from \$6.00 to \$5.00. The Copay for brand name medications will
remain \$7.00. Please post the attached notice about the changes to the PAAD co-
pays.
