- SUBJECT:** To notify pharmacy providers of the changes to the AIDS Drug
Distribution Program (ADDP)
- EFFECTIVE:** Claims with service dates on or after August 1, 2010
- BACKGROUND:** Effective July 1, 2010, the State FY11 Appropriations Act requires
the following changes to ADDP.

Excluded drugs:

Effective August 1, 2010, ADDP will no longer cover the following classes of medications: vitamins, cough/cold medications, drugs used for the treatment of erectile dysfunction, or cosmetic drugs, including but not limited to drugs used for baldness and weight loss.

Change in eligibility:

Effective August 1, 2010 ADDP eligibility will be for those individuals who are below 300 percent of the federal poverty level. The following table outlines the income limits:
