SUBJECT: Updates to the Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS)

EFFECTIVE: **1. Additions:** Effective for Claims with Dates of Service on or after **January 1, 2003**
2. Deletions: Effective for Claims with Dates of Service on or after **July 1, 2003**

PURPOSE: To notify family planning clinics of additions and deletions to the 2003 Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) and reimbursement for Medicaid/NJ FamilyCare fee-for-service covered medical and surgical services

ACTION: The New Jersey Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services (DMAHS) has added new HCPCS procedure codes and their applicable maximum fee allowances. These procedure codes reflect services and maximum fee allowances which are reimbursable to family planning clinics by the New Jersey Medicaid/NJ FamilyCare programs. Providers should use these HCPCS procedure codes when submitting claims for processing.
