**TO:** All Providers

**SUBJECT:** Changes in NJ FamilyCare (NJFC) Plan "H" Coverage

**EFFECTIVE:** June 1, 2004

**PURPOSE:** To notify all providers of a change to the NJFC Plan H benefit package, effective June 1, 2004.

**BACKGROUND:** NJFC Plan H currently provides most health care benefits through health maintenance organizations (HMOs) under contract with the New Jersey Department of Human Services.

**ACTION:** Effective June 1, 2004, Family Planning Services will be added to the benefit package for NJFC Plan H. Family Planning Services include medical history and physical examinations (including pelvic and breast), diagnostic and laboratory tests, drugs and biologicals, medical supplies and devices, counseling, continuing medical supervision, continuity of care and genetic counseling.

Note, however, that services provided primarily for the diagnosis and treatment of infertility, including sterilization reversals, and related office (medical and clinic) visits, drugs, laboratory services, radiological and diagnostic services and surgical procedures are not covered by the NJFC program.

NJFC Plan H enrollees may not obtain family planning services from providers outside their HMO's provider network.

Individuals who participate in NJFC Plan H can be identified by the plan designation value of "H" located in the Message Field of the Beneficiary Identification Card.
