SUBJECT: **NJ State Medicaid Health Information Technology Project (SMHP) Eligible Professional Survey**

PURPOSE: To notify providers of the need to complete and submit the NJ State Medicaid Health Information Technology Project (SMHP) Eligible Professional Survey.

BACKGROUND: Under The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, qualified Eligible Professionals (EP) that meet required Medicaid/NJ FamilyCare fee-for-service (FFS) beneficiary volumes have the opportunity to receive incentives of up to \$63,750 for the implementation of electronic health records.

ACTION: In order to anticipate the amount of incentive funds required, the State of New Jersey has developed a survey to determine the current status of electronic health record and health information technology utilization in New Jersey.
