**SUBJECT:** Implementation of the new HIPAA Version 5010 Institutional Transaction Formats

**EFFECTIVE:** Federally Mandated Date for Claim Submission in the new HIPAA 5010 Transaction Format is January 1, 2012

**BACKGROUND:** Currently, New Jersey MMIS uses the HIPAA version 4010A1 837I transactions for electronic processing of all institutional health care claims. This HIPAA version is being upgraded to the HIPAA version 5010A2 837I as amended and mandated by the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services as the new HIPAA standard transaction for institutional claim submission.

**ACTION:** Claims submitted December 30, 2011 or later will not be accepted unless they are in the new HIPAA 5010 837I format. HIPAA claims submitted prior to December 30, 2011 must be in the HIPAA 4010 837I format. This includes the requirement to discontinue using ICD-9 surgical procedure codes on all outpatient claims as the State will only accept HCPCS surgical procedure codes for these claims.
