SUBJECT: **NJ FamilyCare (NJFC) Moratorium on Enrollment of Medical Suppliers**

EFFECTIVE: Effective on or after July 1, 2018

PURPOSE: To notify medical suppliers of a change in NJFC policy regarding the moratorium on provider enrollment.

BACKGROUND: Since July 1, 2006, a provider moratorium has prohibited the enrollment of new medical suppliers in the NJFC Fee-for-Service (FFS) program, except for medical supplies sold by pharmacies. Medical suppliers who requested limited FFS participation to receive NJFC reimbursement for Medicare deductible and co-insurance payments were permitted to enroll. However, these suppliers were denied NJFC FFS payments for medical supply services when NJFC was the primary payer.

ACTION: Effective on or after July 1, 2018, the moratorium on enrollment of medical suppliers shall be lifted and the NJFC FFS program will begin accepting applications from providers of medical supply services. The enrollment of medical suppliers with a limited enrollment status shall be updated to reflect their full participation as providers in the NJFC FFS program.
