SUBJECT: Pharmaceutical Assistance to the Aged and Disabled (PAAD)  
Program - New Income Eligibility Limits

EFFECTIVE: January 13, 1993 and Retroactive to January 1, 1993

PURPOSE: To inform providers of pharmaceutical services that on January 13, 1993, P.L. 1993, c.3 was signed into law by Governor Florio. One aspect of this legislation increased the Pharmaceutical Assistance to the Aged and Disabled (PAAD) income eligibility limits, retroactive to January 1, 1993, as follows:

Single person - less than \$16,171 (previously \$15,700)  
Married couple - less than \$19,828 (previously \$19,250)

ACTION: PAAD recipients eligible for direct reimbursement, retroactive to January 1, 1993, will receive instructions on how to obtain their reimbursement. They will be required to have their pharmacist complete an MC-6 claim form for each eligible prescription and to return them with a proof of purchase receipt to PAAD for the reimbursement.
