SUBJECT: 21st Century Cures Act

EFFECTIVE: Immediately

PURPOSE: To advise Managed Care network providers under contract with NJ FamilyCare Medicaid managed care organizations (MCOs) to enroll with the NJFC Medicaid fee-for-service (FFS) program in accordance with 21st Century Cures Act requirements.

MCO providers currently enrolled in the NJFC Medicaid FFS program need not take any action in response to this Newsletter.

BACKGROUND: The Medicaid Newsletter Volume 28 No. 06 notified network providers of the requirement that they enroll in the NJFC Medicaid FFS program. Network providers are those providers enrolled in any or all of the five (5) NJFC Medicaid MCOs.

The 21st Century Cures Act, 42 U.S.C. 1396u-2(d), requires that network providers complete the 21st Century Cures Act provider application. Seven (7) out of ten (10) network providers have successfully enrolled in the FFS program. **Compliance is mandatory. Failure to comply may result in a provider's contract with an MCO being terminated.**

ACTION: Network providers are required to submit a completed 21st Century Cures Act application to DXC Technology. Providers under contract with multiple MCOs are only required to submit a single 21st Century Cures Act application to DXC Technology.

To download a 21st Century Cures Act application, go to www.njmmis.com, select "Provider Enrollment Applications," and then select **21st Century Cures Act Application** as the "Provider Type."

- NJFC MCO providers who are eligible to serve **FFS beneficiaries** and wish to do so must complete a full NJFC FFS enrollment application in order to be enrolled as a FFS Medicaid Provider. This application can be found at www.njmmis.com under "Provider

Enrollment Application.” Please note there are some Provider Types that are not eligible to enroll in FFS Medicaid.

- Providers who choose to serve **only Medicaid MCO beneficiaries** are referred to as 21st Century Cures registered or ROPA (referring, ordering, prescribing or attending) providers in the NJFC FFS program.
 - 21st Century Cures registered providers are **not eligible** to receive NJFC FFS payments.
 - 21st Century Cures registered providers are not required to provide services to NJFC FFS beneficiaries.
 - 21st Century Cures providers shall not be listed in the NJFC FFS Provider Directory and will not be assigned a FFS Medicaid ID number.

Question: Are all MCO network providers required to submit the 21st Century Cures Provider application?

Answer: Yes, all providers that participate in a NJFC MCO provider network must complete either a full NJFC FFS enrollment application or the 21st Century Cures provider application.
