TO: Drug Treatment Centers

SUBJECT: Updates to the HCFA Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) for Drug Treatment Services

EFFECTIVE: Claims with service dates on or after March 1, 1997

PURPOSE: To notify drug treatment centers of updates to HCFA Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) procedure codes

BACKGROUND: The New Jersey Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services (DMAHS) has adopted new HCPCS procedure codes for the evaluation and management of substance abuse when provided in physician office settings or independent clinics. The HCPCS procedure codes are in accordance with the physicians Current Procedure Terminology (CPT). Please note that the new HCPCS codes replace procedure codes formerly billed for office visits, and reflect no changes in current Medicaid policy or maximum fee allowances.

ACTION: For claims with service dates on or after March 1, 1997, DMAHS has **deleted** the following HCPCS procedure codes:
