The following state agencies – the Medicaid Fraud Division (MFD) of the Office of the State Comptroller, the Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services (DMAHS) within the Department of Human Services, and the Medicaid Fraud Control Unit (MFCU) in the Attorney General’s Office – work together with New Jersey’s Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) to prevent, identify and recover overpayments caused by fraud, waste, and abuse in the Medicaid program (often referred to as NJ FamilyCare). This session is designed to provide stakeholders, specifically Allergy and Immunology providers, a better understanding of best practices to prevent and detect fraud, waste, and abuse in the New Jersey Medicaid program.
