Useful Information for a Compliant Medicaid Provider: An Overview of Medicaid Fraud Detection & Prevention

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

New Jersey is one of many states investigating Medicaid home care providers' use, abuse, and misuse of federal and state funds. Several state agencies—the Medicaid Fraud Division (MFD), the Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services (DMAHS), and the Medicaid Fraud Control Unit (MFCU)—are working with New Jersey's Managed Care Organizations to identify fraud, waste, and abuse within the home care industry.



Attend this first of its kind program to learn:

- why inspections and investigations are taking place
- how the MCOs and NJ Medicaid agencies work together in detection
- which preventative measures agencies should proactively implement to **reduce risk**
- how billing errors, improper billing practices and documentation mistakes can potentially impact your bottom line
