## ATTENTION NEW JERSEY FAMILYCARE NJFC)/MEDICAID BENEFICIARIES NOT ENROLLED IN MANAGED CARE

Effective January 1, 2013, a practitioner that refers, orders, operates, prescribes or attends to your healthcare needs must be enrolled as a billing or 'non-billing' provider in the NJFC/Medicaid Program in order for a healthcare service covered by Medicaid to be paid for by the State of New Jersey. Typical healthcare services may include, but not be limited to prescriptions, diagnostic tests, or physician office visits. Your healthcare provider may advise you of this requirement when you request a covered healthcare service.

If your healthcare provider is not currently enrolled as a provider in the NJFC/Medicaid Program, the healthcare service you requested will not be paid for by the State. You will need to request your healthcare service from an enrolled practitioner, or you may choose to pay for the service you are requesting.
