# MEDICAID ALERT

MARCH 1992

**TO:** Providers of Transportation Services

**SUBJECT:** Transportation Certification Form

**EFFECTIVE:** Immediately

**ACTION:** It is no longer necessary to attach a transportation certification form to a transportation claim form when submitting a claim to Unisys/Paramax for ambulance, invalid coach, or livery service.

A transportation certification form must continue to be completed, as required at N.J.A.C. 10:50-1.7, and must be retained on file at your place of business and made available for review upon request by staff of the Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services or Unisys/Paramax.

If a transportation certification form is not on file for each service, Medicaid reimbursement for the service is subject to recoupment, as indicated at N.J.A.C. 10:49-1.26(c)1.

The vehicle fleet number (livery) or the vehicle recognition number (ambulance and invalid coach) that corresponds to the vehicle used to provide the respective transportation service must be entered on the "Transportation Claim" (Form MC-12) in Item 18 (REMARKS) when submitting a hard copy claim to Unisys/Paramax for ambulance, invalid coach, or livery service.
