(ROUTE TO: Accounting, Finance and Billing Offices)

SUBJECT: Revenue Center Codes - Accommodation Days

EFFECTIVE: Immediately

PURPOSE: To Provide Instructions for Billing Accommodation Days

ACTION: Several issues regarding the billing of accommodation days on hospital inpatient claims require clarification. Please follow these instructions for billing:

1. **FOR MEDICAID DRG HOSPITALS:** Do not enter on one claim the charges and units for inpatient accommodations for the mother and the newborn. Two separate claims must be submitted:
 - A. One for the mother using appropriate revenue center codes, charges, units; and
 - B. One for the newborn using appropriate revenue center codes, charges, units.

Edit 489 will be posted to your claim if you enter both mother and newborn accommodation revenue center codes on one claim. You may enter on both claim forms the HSP (Medicaid) Number of the mother if the HSP (Medicaid) Number of the newborn is not available.

All revenue center codes, including 090 (Skilled Nursing Facility), 092 (Intermediate), and 093 (Residential) must be entered on the claim form and precede Revenue Center Code 001 (Total Charges). Revenue Center Code 001 must be the last revenue center code entered on the claim form.

When entering charges and units for 090, 092, and 093, do not include these charges/units in any other accommodation revenue center code, charges or units. The sum of all charges entered on the claim must be equal to the 001 (Total Charges) amount.

2. **FOR ALL HOSPITALS:** The sum of the days entered in Field 2 (Acute, SNF, ICF, Residential) must equal the sum of the units entered in Field 52 for each accommodation revenue center code entered on the claim form. Edit 660 will post to your claim if the sum of the days entered in Field 2 does not equal the sum of the accommodation revenue center code units entered in Field 52.

NOTE THE FOLLOWING REVENUE CENTER CODES:

1. Revenue center codes for use in identifying hospital inpatient accommodations for the mother are as follows:

110-112	134-142	180-202
114-122	144-152	204-209
124-132	154-169	

2. Revenue center codes for use in identifying hospital inpatient accommodations for the newborn are as follows:

170-179 and 203.
