ROUTE TO: Billing, Accounting and Finance Offices

SUBJECT: Recovery for Claims Paid for CCPED and HCEP Recipients

EFFECTIVE: Immediately

BACKGROUND: Hospitals have billed and been inappropriately paid for hospital services rendered to recipients of the Community Care Program for the Elderly and Disabled (CCPED) and the Home Care Expansion Program (HCEP) since November 1991. These two special home care programs, CCPED and HCEP, provide a restricted package of seven home and community-based services to the recipient which does not include hospital services. Recovery by Medicaid for claims for hospital services provided on and after November 1, 1991 is indicated.

ACTION: The New Jersey Medicaid program will process an automated recovery of inappropriately paid claims for hospital services for recipients eligible only for CCPED and HCEP services. The recovery will appear as a "RECEIVABLE" on future Remittance Advices (RA) from the Medicaid fiscal agent.
