# MEDICAID ALERT

November 1995

**TO:** All Providers  
**SUBJECT:** Special Claims (Judge Run) Reports  
**EFFECTIVE:** Immediately

**BACKGROUND:** As an additional service, all providers can now purchase special reports (known as Judge Run reports) from Unisys that detail and summarize all adjudicated claims. These reports can relay information dating back to 1989 and are fixed in both format and sort sequence. The format is beneficiary name, beneficiary HSP number, Internal Control Number (ICN), date of service, service code, payment date and amount. The report is sequenced by claim type, beneficiary name, beneficiary HSP number, date of service, and payment date. There is a charge to the provider for this service.

**ACTION:** Providers can order Judge Run reports by completing and mailing the attached Judge Run Request Form or by contacting a Provider Services representative at 1-800-776-6334. Claims that are to appear on the report may be selected by either date of service or date of payment.

Judge Run reports are produced on a monthly basis. Requests for reports need to be received by the 15th of the month in which they are processed.

A summary report and invoice will be sent to the requesting provider no later than the 10th of the month following the month in which the initial request was received. The charge by Unisys will be based on the number of printed claim lines:

Up to 1,000 claim lines	\$150.00
1,001 to 25,000 claim lines	\$325.00
25,001 to 50,000 claim lines	\$375.00
50,001 to 75,000 claim lines	\$400.00
75,001 to 100,000 claim lines	\$450.00
100,001 to 125,000 claim lines	\$475.00
125,001 to 150,000 claim lines	\$525.00
Over 150,000 claim lines	\$550.00

Upon receipt of payment, the detailed Judge Run report will be sent immediately to the requesting provider.
